

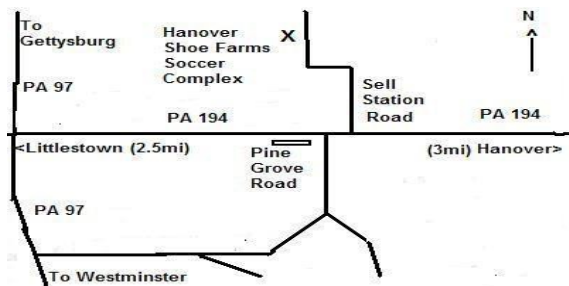
Directions to Hanover Shoe Farms, Sells Station Road Site:

From West or South: Rt. 97 to Littlestown. At the traffic light take Rt. 194 North to Sell Station Road. Left on Sell Station; 1.3 miles to site.

From East and North: Rt. 194 South out of Hanover. Sells Station Road is 0.8 miles past the main entrance to Hanover Shoe Farms. Turn right on Sell Station; 1.3 miles to the site.

CBARRC Lure Coursing Procedures

1. **No food will be served.** Please bring your own breakfast, lunch, dinner, and drinks.
2. **No water or shade will be provided.** Please bring your own water and shade for yourself and your dogs.
3. The Field Trial Secretary will wear a facial covering and gloves while performing duties, to the extent feasible.
4. Day of Test/Trial Entries will require Owner/Agent to present a check or exact cash for entry fees while wearing gloves.
5. All attendees/participants are required to follow state and local [COVID-19 Guidelines](#) that apply to Littlestown, PA.
6. All attendees will practice social distancing of 10 feet (to allow for hounds pulling beyond a six-foot distance).
7. All attendees will avoid congregating to the extent possible.
8. All attendees will avoid shaking hands and hugging.
9. All attendees will practice social distancing while under the Pavilion.
10. There will be no Pre-Course Briefing.
11. All attendees will familiarize themselves with this Premium List.
12. All attendees will familiarize themselves with the [AKC Regulations for Lure Coursing Tests and Trials](#).
13. All attendees agree to wear their mask to fully cover their mouth and nose.
14. All Field Committee and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings and gloves while performing duties.
15. All attendees will wear facial coverings when away from their vehicle.
16. All attendees will adhere to any “X” spots to mark keeping the appropriate social distance of ten feet.
17. All attendees will park at least 10 feet away from other vehicles and follow all guidance from the Parking Attendant.
18. The Inspection Committee will wear gloves and facial coverings during inspection.

19. Roll Call will be conducted at the cars with masked owners observing social distancing of 10 feet.
20. Owners will be asked to wipe their own females and show the Inspection Committee the used tissue.
21. Wickets will be wiped down with disinfectant after each dog is measured.
22. Huntmasters will stand a minimum of 10 feet from the hounds.
23. The lures will be tied onto the string no less than 10 feet apart to reduce congestion during the retrieval of hounds.
24. Hand washing stations and/or instant hand sanitizer and/or wet wipes will be made available.
25. All attendees agree to leave the Porta John doors propped open when not in use.
26. Running Orders will be posted as usual.
27. IF requested, we will use a bull horn to notify handlers if they choose to stay by their car.
28. Running orders will be sent out before the trial.
29. No self-serve ribbons will be available due to potential cross contamination.
30. All hounds will refrain from soiling COVID-19 signs on the ground.

Above all, have fun with your hounds and be safe!



WHAT MUST MY DOG DO TO PASS THE C.A.T.? The Coursing Ability Test (C.A.T.) is a pass/fail test. In order to pass, the dog must chase the plastic lure, and complete the course 1 time, by himself, with enthusiasm and without interruption within the maximum amount of time. The judge keeps the official time and decides the merits of the dog's performance. **If there is a question which course a dog should run, the judge will decide.**

DOGS LESS THAN 12" TALL & "FLAT FACED" DOGS. Any entrant that is less than 12" tall at the withers and/or brachycephalic (bulldog) will run a clearly marked 300-yard course that is basically rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 300-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 1 ½ minutes.

DOGS MORE THAN 12" TALL. Any entrant that is taller than 12" at the withers and not brachycephalic shall run a clearly marked 600-yard course (or as close to 600 yards as possible) that is basically rectangular in shape with turns no more acute than 90 degrees. For a 600-yard course, a dog must complete the test in less than 2 minutes.

CAN MY DOG EARN AN AKC TITLE FOR COURSING ABILITY? Three titles will be awarded for dogs that pass the Coursing Ability Test the required number of times. These are suffix titles that will appear on a dog's pedigree with a higher-level title superseding a lower level title.

Coursing Ability (CA) – Awarded to a dog that passes the Coursing Ability Test three times under at least two different judges.

Coursing Ability Advanced (CAA) - Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test ten times.

Coursing Ability Excellent (CAX) – Dog passes the Coursing Ability Test 25 times.

- " Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" found on the Official AKC Entry Form.
- " Mixed breeds must be spayed or neutered to be eligible to run. AKC registered dogs with breed disqualifications may be entered.
- " Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are old, have breathing problems, heart problems, are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test, and in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded.
- " Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- " The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve a testing dog.
- " Any decisions made by the event's officiating judge(s) regarding the performance of an entered dog shall be final. Full discretionary power is given to the judge(s) to withhold any and all qualifications for lack of merit. The Judge(s) is responsible for ensuring compliance with the AKC Regulations on the field.
- " No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or

any other cause beyond the control of the Club or its members and representatives.

WHAT IF MY DOG IS SICK THAT DAY? Please do not bring a sick, or lame dog, or a female in-season, to this event. Call the secretary, Linda Davis, 202-774-8424 and cancel your entry. Your check will be destroyed.

HANDLING. Dogs should run wearing a close fitting buckle collar. Choke collars and collars with tags or dangling decoration will not be allowed. Slip leads can be used if the owner desires and will be provided to borrow. Dogs should be retrieved promptly by the owner/ handler at the end of the course.

ROLL CALL and INSPECTION~ dogs will be inspected by a designated Inspection Committee consisting of at least two persons who are members of the Field Committee and who shall inspect each entered dog for lameness, fitness to compete and female estrus (in season). In the opinion of the Inspection Committee, any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, or in season, your dog will not be allowed to run and the entry fees shall be refunded. Any dog entered, not checking in at this time, will be marked absent.

RUN ORDER LIST ~ this is a posted list of the running order for the dogs participating in the event. This list will be posted about 10 minutes after roll-call is completed. Check the run order list, to see when your dog will run
