

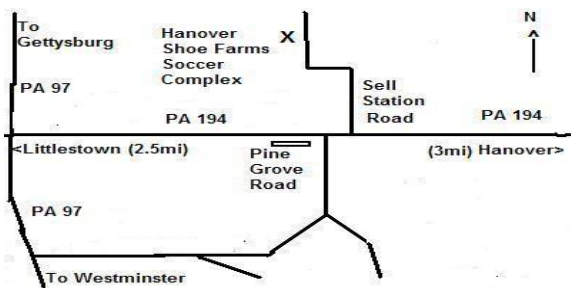
Directions to Hanover Shoe Farms, Sells Station Road Site:

From East and North: Rt. 194 South out of Hanover. Sells Station Road is 0.8 miles past the main entrance to Hanover Shoe Farms. Turn right on Sell Station; 1.3 miles to the site.

Map of area:

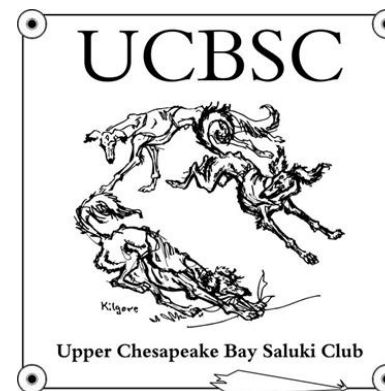

Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell’Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (ILP/PAL included), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound’s first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion of record.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. Points go toward V-FCh or V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLE STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

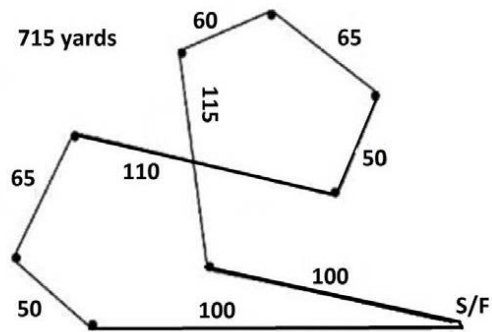

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

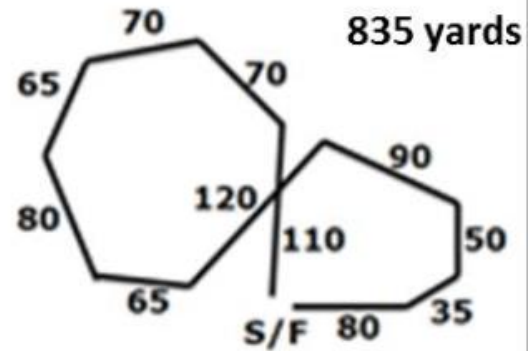
All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial • Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more • Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. •Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. • Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake • Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched • All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. • **There will be a \$40 fee for all bounced checks!!!!** •

All-Bred Lure Coursing Trials over both days of competition.

GRANDE PRIX CHALLENGE CUP TROPHIES are awarded to overall **Best of Breed(s)**

BEST IN GRANDE PRIX ELIMINATION TROPHY is awarded to the **Best in Field Winner**.

BREED TROPHIES

DRAKULA Challenge Cup for Afghan Hounds: Donated by Bob and Linda Jordan, Windcrest Afghans, in honor of FC Utchati Kount Drakula Qamari, LCM II, ORC

BETTE Challenge Cup for Basenji: Donated by Dave and Carol Phelps, Patrician Basenjis, in honor of Patrician Sheena Crimson Art, LCM III

AURIUM Challenge Cup for Borzoi: Donated by Diana Darling in honor of FC Mayberry's Aurium of Rhyka. Aurium was #1 Borzoi in ASFA, AKC, CKC, and Open Field in 1993, and is the only hound to have achieved this remarkable feat.

PANDAHARI PAT Challenge Cup for Greyhounds: Donated by Bonnie Dalzell, SilkenSwift Borzoi, in honor of Treybeau's Fantasy, LCM VII. Fantasy was the #1 Greyhound in 1985, and from 1987 thru 1991. The cup was lost in a fire in 1997, and has been replaced by Dean Wright.

DUKE Challenge Cup for Ibizan Hounds: Donated this year by Peter and Judy Parker (upon their retirement of the FLYER Cup). It is donated in memory of, and to honor, Allura, Magnum, Lizzy, Portia, and Duke; all previous winners of the FLYER Cup. Lizzy was also was a former winner of the Best in Grande Prix Elimination Trophy.

GINA Challenge Cup for Italian Greyhounds: Donated by Don and Nancy Ewing in honor of Skyline Gina Beau, SC, who was rescued in 1998 and was shy and retiring until she discovered lure coursing!

MAKO Challenge Cup for Irish Wolfhounds: Donated by Joseph Grillo, in honor of Seawolf's Mako McQueen CD, FCH, who was the IW BOB Winner at the inaugural ASFA II.

MISTER Challenge Cup for Pharaoh Hounds: Donated by Peter and Carmen Day, retired by FC Aspen Hill Aureus LCM III, and re-donated in honor of Kamaraj Seker LCM VIII

KUSHINDA Challenge Cup for Rhodesian Ridgebacks: Donated by The Lion Hounds of Kushinda in honor of the AKC 2006 #1 MBIF FC Kushinda Impee-Deeing Factor TBV MC LCX, #2 FC Kushinda's Torque N Turn KDH MC, #3 FC Kushinda's Magnolia Wine TBV SC, #11 Kushinda's Grand Marquis KDH SC, #14 FC Kushinda's Butterfly Chaser RG SC, and #16 FC Kushinda Good Night Olivia UK SC, and #20 FC Kushinda Good Night Erin UK SC; and ASFA 2006 #1 MBIF FC Kushinda Impee-Deeing Factor TBV MC LCX, #2 FC Kushinda's Magnolia Wine TBV SC, #5 FC Kushinda's Torque N Turn KDH MC, #8 Kushinda's Grand Marquis KDH SC, and #17 FC Kushinda's Butterfly Chaser RG SC Rhodesian Ridgebacks; and AKC ALL-BREED 2006 #1 MBIF FC Kushinda Impee-Deeing Factor TBV MC LCX, #8 FC Kushinda's Torque N Turn KDH MC, and #9 FC Kushinda's Magnolia Wine TBV SC hounds!

FLING Challenge Cup for Scottish Deerhounds: Retired and then re-donated by Vale Vue, Bob and Norma Sellers. Fairyfort's Highland Fling was BOB at the first ASFA II, and was #1 SD in 1977 and 1998

RALPH THE WHIPPET Challenge Cup for Whippets: Donated by Jack McManus in honor of CH Sundance Haut Brion LCM IX (Brie).

These Eastern Seaboard trials were conceived to provide a true test of our hounds' agility, speed and endurance on two separate course plans, each with a specific challenge. At the end of the two trials we will know the fastest, most agile, and enduring hound in each breed. They will be awarded the Breed Grande Prix Challenge Cups. All Breed Challenge Cup Winners will then be eligible to compete for the Best in Grande Prix Elimination Trophy.

RULES

A HOUND MUST COMPETE ON BOTH DAYS TO WIN A GRANDE PRIX BREED CHALLENGE CUP

The Breed Challenge Cup Winner will be the hound that wins Best of Breed on both days. If the same hound does not win BOB both days, then the winner will be determined by a run-off between the BOB winner from each day, and also the hound which defeated the most hounds in its breed over the two days without winning a BOB. The Breed Challenge Cups are silver champagne coolers which honor the outstanding lure coursing hounds in each breed. They are retired to any owner who wins one three times.

All judges will judge the Grande Prix Perpetual Trophy elimination run(s) (if possible). A random draw will determine courses. Hounds winning each course will re-compete, until the **Grande Prix Perpetual Trophy Winner** is determined via elimination.
