

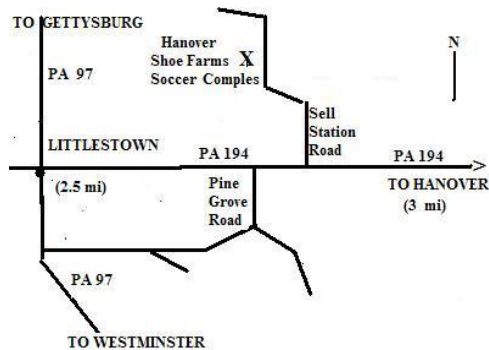
Directions to Hanover Shoe Farms, Sells Station Road Site:

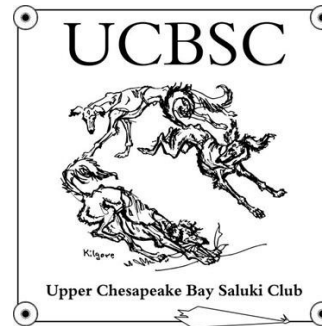

Eligibility

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco Dell'etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Italian Greyhounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis and Whippets, at least one year of age, that have been registered with The American Kennel Club or an AKC recognized foreign registry are eligible to enter. Dogs of these breeds recorded with the Purebred Alternative Listing Program/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) or dogs with Conditional registration are eligible to participate. Foundation Stock Service Breeds eligible to compete for suffix titles only are the Thai Ridgeback. **Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate accept in the Single Stake. FSS breeds may earn suffix titles only.**

Stakes Offered

OPEN: Open to all hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser certificate OR ASFA Certification. This requirement will be waived for hounds that have earned a Field Championship title from the American Sighthound Field Association (ASFA) or the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC). ASFA or CKC Field Champions must submit a copy of their title certificate or ASFA Cert to the host club when they enter their first AKC Open Stake. This copy must be included when the results of the trial are sent to the AKC. Championship points earned from the Open Stake will only count toward a Field Champion title.

OPEN VETERAN: Open to all hounds, which are eligible to enter the Open or Special Stake and are of Veteran age as determined by their Parent Breed Club. Field Championship or LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

SPECIAL: Open to all hounds that have earned their AKC Field Championship titles. LCX points may be awarded from this stake.

Hounds under disqualification from AKC, ASFA or CKC Field Trials may **NOT** be entered.

SINGLE STAKE: Open to all sighthound breeds approved to participate in AKC Lure Coursing trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in the Singles Stake shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials or veteran) at the same event. Each hound shall run the course alone. Single Stake entries from all breeds shall be combined to determine placements. Placements shall be awarded based on the combined preliminary and final course scores. The winner of the stake shall not be eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field courses.

Junior Courser: Open to all eligible sighthounds. A hound running alone must receive a certification from a Judge on one date, and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, with each Judge stating that the hound completed a (minimum) 600-yard course with a minimum of 4 turns. The hound must complete the entire course with enthusiasm and without interruption. Ribbons (Dark Green) will be awarded to all hounds that successfully complete the AKC Junior Courser Test.

Qualified Courser: Open to hounds that are at least 12 months of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed - or another breed with a similar running style - (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption, sufficiently course the lure and not course the Testing Hound. The judge will certify that the Qualifying Hound ran cleanly and did not appear to present a hazard to the Testing Hound at any point in the qualifying course. **This certificate is required to enter a hound in an Open Stake.**

Best in Field (BIF): Will be offered

Portuguese Podengo Pequenos and FSS Breeds are ineligible to compete for Best in Field

Conditions of Entry

All entries must be at least one year of age on the day of the trial.

Hounds not present at time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period

Stakes may be split if sufficient entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw to support more than one 5-point Major.

Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Entries will be refunded.

Hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications, hounds with breed disqualifications, as listed in the AKC Breed Standards, are ineligible to enter lure coursing trials and tests. But MAY be entered in the Singles Stake. Spayed and neutered hounds are eligible to participate. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are ineligible to participate.

Dogs with Limited Registration are eligible to participate.

A \$5.00 fine will be assessed for any loose hound on the field that is not competing in the course in progress.

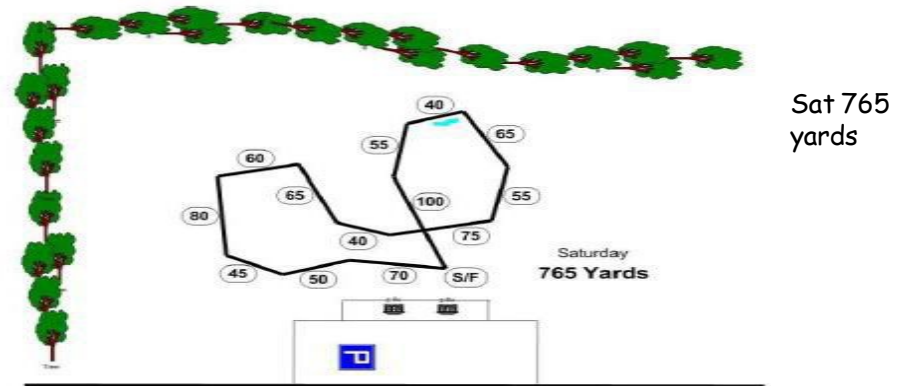
Battery powered, continuous loop equipment will be used. Lures consist of white plastic. Back-up equipment will be available.

UCBSC reserves the right to alter course plans due to field and/or weather conditions on the day of the trial. The course will be reversed for finals, run-offs and BOB.

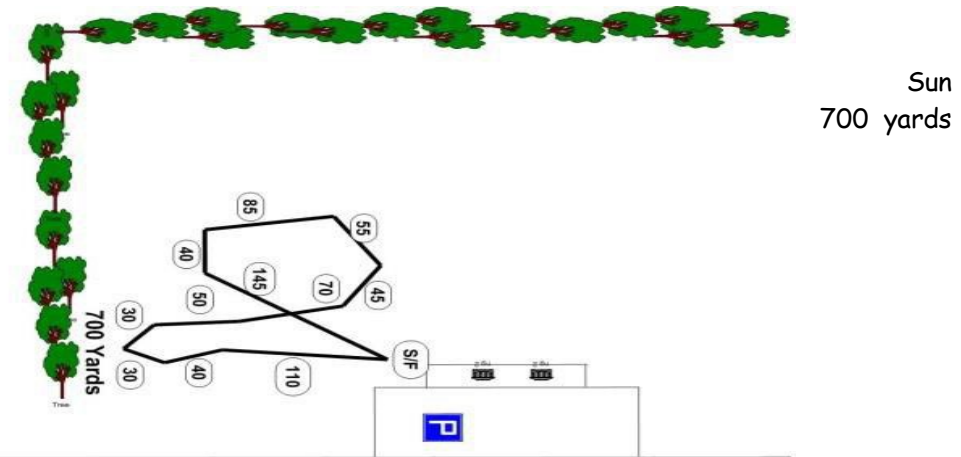
The field is board fenced; shade is limited, and adequate shade and cooling/drinking water should be provided by participants.

Hanover Lure Coursing Procedures

We will follow State and local guidelines.

1. All unvaccinated Field Committee and Lure Operators should wear facial coverings and gloves.
2. All unvaccinated participants should wear facial coverings.
3. No food will be served, bring your own breakfast and lunches. Sorry!!! Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs. None will be available at this time.
4. We ask that you park at a safe distance away from each other.
5. Roll Call will be done at the pavilion. The roll call committee will wear gloves and facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
6. Wickets will be wiped down after each dog.
7. We will have instant hand sanitizer or wet wipes everywhere.
8. We will prop open the porty pots when not in use for more air flow to cut down on bacteria.
9. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
10. At the starting line, all dogs will stand 6 feet apart.
11. Practice social distancing the best you can. I know we all have been cooped up but act responsibly!!
12. Please be aware of the running orders will be posted as usual, if needed, we will use a bull horn to notify you if you choose to stay by your car.
13. We will also post running orders and scores on our Facebook page.
14. No self-serve ribbons anymore due to cross contamination.

Field Setup

- ◆ Come early (one hour before roll call) and start by carrying equipment.
- ◆ Learn as you go how to place pulleys and tie downs, eventually

Field Clerk

- ◆ Volunteer to help the field clerk for even one or two breeds
- ◆ Learn how scores are tabulated and recorded - when you are comfortable with this you will be able to start helping the field trial secretary.
- ◆ The benefit is you will get a whole new perspective on the course and may learn by listening to the judges.

Runner

- ◆ Volunteer to run paperwork from the field clerk to the field trial secretary after each breed has run.
- ◆ Scores can only be posted as quickly as the paperwork is delivered to the field trial secretary.

Lure Operator

- ◆ Hang around and talk to the lure operator between courses
- ◆ If you are interested, try running the lure around before the trial, at lunch or after the trial at practice.

Practice

- ◆ Give the volunteers who have been working all day a break!
- ◆ Take the practice list, call out the names and collect the money.

Fundraiser

- ◆ It's great when people donate things, but even better if you can organize and execute a fundraiser whether it be a 50/50 draw, silent auction, raffle etc. It doesn't have to be complicated or too time consuming.
- ◆ Feel free to do this at any HANOVER trial!

 - Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Spayed, neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
 - Hounds with breed disqualifications and monorchid or cryptorchid hounds are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake
 - Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched
 - All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure machines will be used. The lure will consist of white plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available. The course will be reversed for the finals, runoffs and Best of Breed.
- The members of UCBSC reserve the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions on the date of the trial. Exhibitors are requested to not bring bitches known to be in season to the field.

There will be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound not participating in the course. Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee.

The field is board fenced; camping is permitted, but there is NO electricity or water.

Children must be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.

ALL RETURNED CHECKS WILL BE CHARGED A \$40 FEE.
